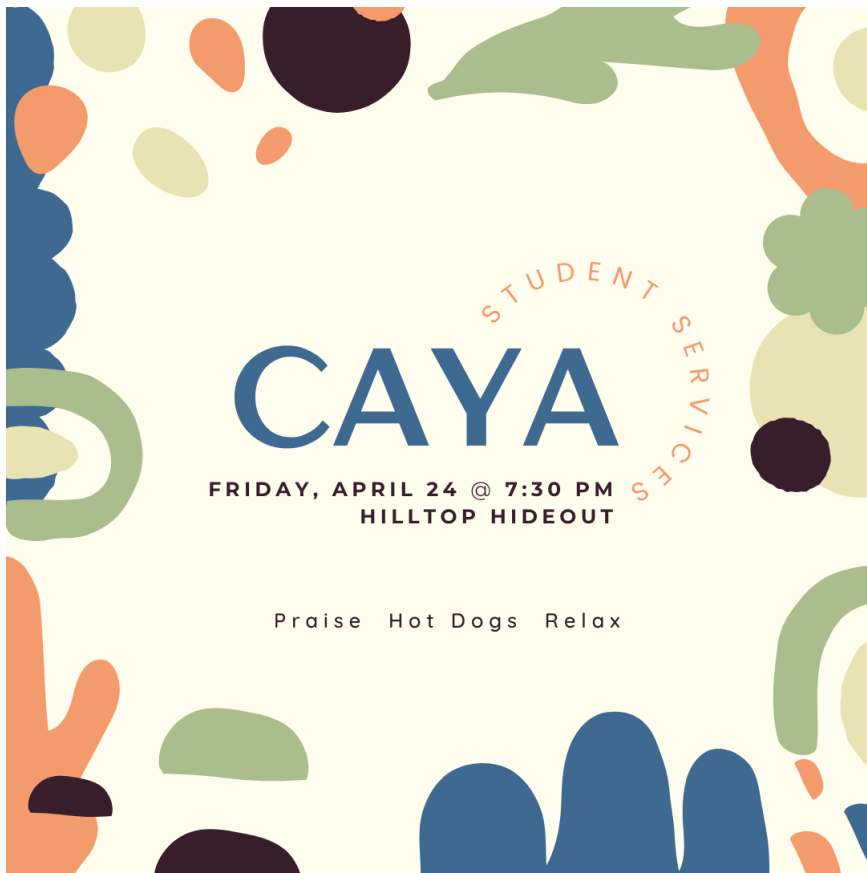

**APPLICATION DEADLINE: MAY 5**

This award recognizes those students who hold leadership positions or participate in significant service activities on the Burman campus, in their local church, or in the community during the current school year. This award is redeemed in the upcoming school year, not the current one.

### Application Eligibility:

- Applicants must be a full-time student at Burman University and complete 12 credits each fall and winter term of the current school year.
- Applicants must have achieved a 2.3 or 2.5 GPA in the current school year (Depends on the student's declared program of study and the required GPA for graduation).
- Applicants must hold a leadership position (excluding paid hourly employment) or participate in significant service activities from September to April in the current school year.
- Applicants must submit an application and references before the deadline.
- Students are ineligible to receive this award if they are receiving a second-degree discount or a full tuition scholarship.
- Course requirements and hourly paid employment do not qualify for leadership or service in regards to the scholarship criteria.

### Redemption Eligibility:

- To claim this award a student must register for and successfully complete a minimum of 12 credits (excluding PLAR and audits) during the upcoming fall and winter terms.
- The total award amount will be divided equally between the two terms of the upcoming school year, \$750 each semester.

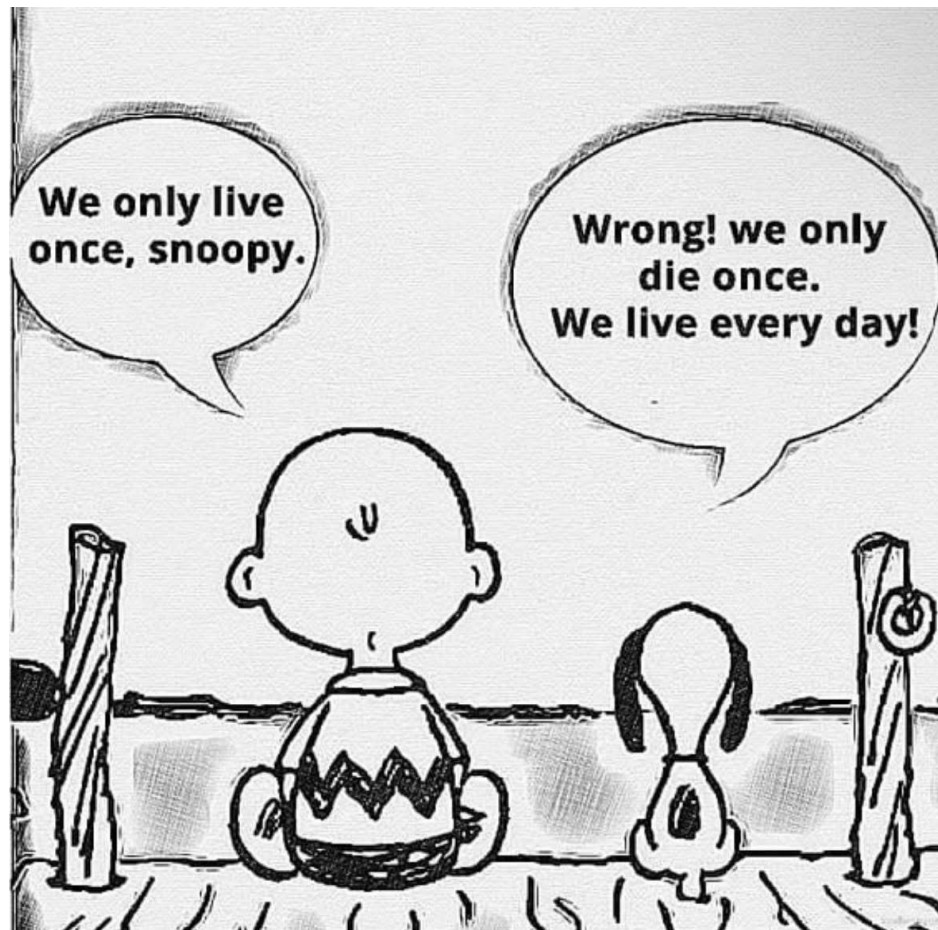
