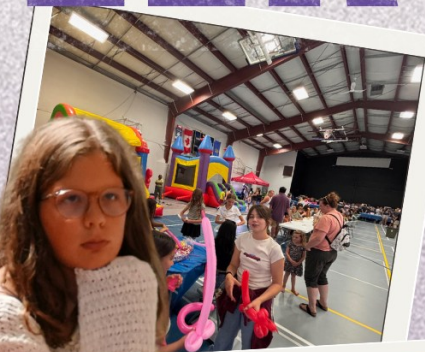

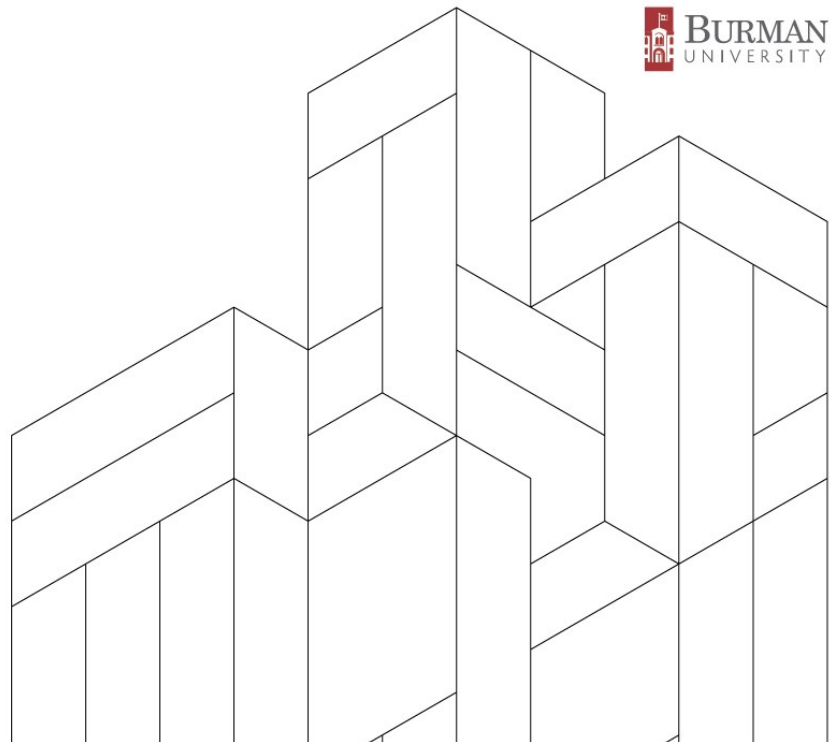

For fundraising purposes towards future events and the services of Anam Rural Youth, there will be a **silent auction** on site as well as white shirt sales.

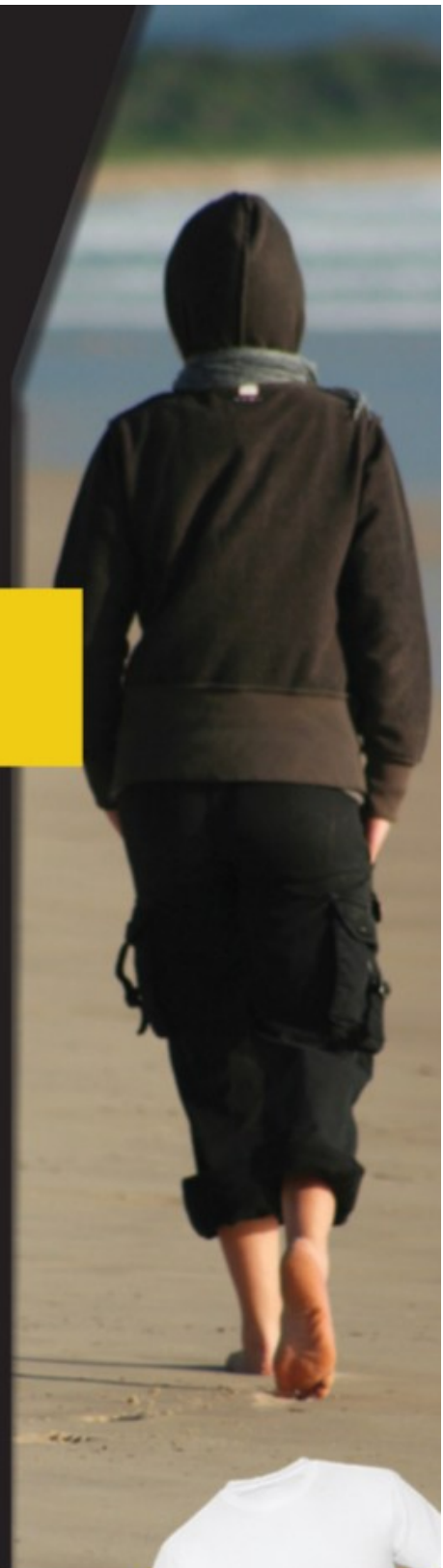
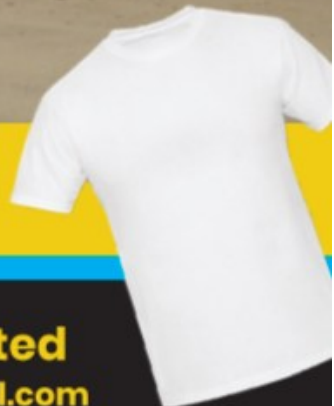
