Dany Pen is also the Executive Director of Raleigh International Bermuda; and the Founder of Women's A.C.T., an International Advocacy Group that promotes equality, justice, empowerment and support for women who are survivors of domestic abuse, violence and sexual assault.

She also serves as a missionary and on the Adventist Community Services (ACS) Team at the Warwick Seventh-day Adventist Church. The ACS Team helps to serve the church and wider community through the following ministries:

- Community Development/Urban Ministry;
