

PROFESSOR RECEIVES GRANT

Dr. Delano Lewis, Burman University Associate Professor of Biology, Receives an \$8,000 TD Friends of the Environment Foundation grant to conduct a citizen science project at Ellis Bird Farm in the summer 2023.

PROJECT DETAILS

- Creation of butterfly monitoring trail with signage at Ellis Bird Farm
- Training of Burman students and community members to identify and count butterflies along a specified 1 km path.
- Data gathered will feed into a larger long term project looking at the effect of weather changes on butterfly diversity and evenness.
