
Using the Schedule

- Time for an exam: Determine the first period your course is scheduled to meet in a week and find it in the grid. Example: If a class has its first period of a Tuesday at 1:15 pm, your exam time for that class will be on Friday, December 9 starting at 8:00 am*.
- Friday 8:00-10:50 slot to be arranged by Instructor if needed.
- All examinations will be held in the Burman Gymnasium. Exceptions to be approved by the VPAA.

GYM EXAM REGULATIONS

- Arrive to your exam at least 10 minutes before start time.
- . No entrance allowed after 30 minutes from the start of exam.
- If you are late for the exam, you must provide a legitimate reason to the Registrar before being admitted.
- You must remain in the exam room for at least 30 minutes.
- Exams are 3 hours long, no additional time will be given.
- Bring only materials approved by your professor.
- No use of earbuds or headsets.
- Leave phones at home. If you must bring your phone, make sure to turn it off. It should not be visible at any time during exam.
