Dr. Torben Bergland is one of The Associate Directors of the Health Ministries Department of the General Conference of Seventh-day Adventists, the Global Headquarter of the Seventh-day Adventist Church. As a psychiatrist and psychotherapist, he has taken a special interest in working with patients with depression, anxiety, and personality disorders, as well as integrating relational, religious, and existential perspectives in psychotherapy. He is a cyclist, runner, skier, and has climbed nine 4,000+ meter (13,000+ ft) mountains in the Alps, among them Mont Blanc (4810 m/15,780 ft), the highest mountain in Western Europe. He considers it to be a great privilege to serve God and the Church through the gifts he has been given.
